A colourful Butterfly to hang in your window

To make this decoration you are going to sandwich coloured tissue between two card butterflies. Read all the instructions before you start.

You will need: scissors, glue, colouring pens or crayons, coloured tissue or clear film, thin card on which to print the butterflies, thread or ribbon to hang your butterfly.

What to do:

- 1. The black areas on the butterflies are where the holes for your tissue paper are going to be. If you wish you can make these bigger and have larger holes.
- 2. Decorate the areas of your butterflies that you are not going to cut out. Or you may choose to use the butterflies as a stencil and make your decoration with black card which is very effective.
- 3. Cut out your butterflies and the holes where the tissue paper will be.
- 4. Take one of your butterflies and stick tissue paper over the holes on the side that you have not decorated.
- 5. Carefully stick the other butterfly on top, making sure all the edges are tidy. Leave to dry.
- 6. You may want to find something to use for the butterfly antennae.
- 7. Hang your butterfly in your window where the sun can shine through it.
