Summer Fair:

The date for the fair has been changed to 6th July 2019 so is now a Summer rather than Spring Fair.

The logistics for the barbecue were discussed. Duncan and Liz used to run this but are moving so will not be available. They have left the barbecue equipment for us to use.

We will need to work out quantities of burgers, buns etc to be purchased and will also need freezer space to store them before the fair. Dave will speak to Duncan about this. Nicola and Frances are happy to help out flipping burgers on the day but we will hopefully have another volunteer to take charge. Dave to make enquiries.

We need to organise flyers in advance to advertise the date and request donations of cakes, plants and items for the tombola.

Clare pointed out that the change of date will affect the plants available for the plant stall. Cut flowers were also suggested.

Donations

We have commissioned a canal themed pop-up art exhibition for the bicentenary which will be over the late August Bank holiday.
