FOG Report

- 1. FAUNA opened successfully on Thursday December 22nd and we have subsequently had good coverage in the Lancaster Guardian and on Radio Lancashire.
- 2. Rules and Regulations now posted including Permissive Path note.
- 3. City Council may have to co-sign agreement for official "Permissive Path" which will allow us to display the path on OS maps.
- 4. Council bin arrived and has been emptied.
- 5. Ideas about funding the carving of the Cromwell Rd end stone were discussed.
- 6. Correspondence has been received from the Harries family on the subject of the fields purchase.
- 7. Containers as a possible tool shed solution were discussed and it was resolved to revert to FOG with Michael's costings (approx £1300). Reliable information suggests that cheaper

- or free containers are either damaged or stolen. Rob said he would also be able to make enquiries at Fleetwood.
- 8. Insurers have been updated, although we await confirmation. Oliver will provide an asset register which we can forward to them.
- 9. Orchard volunteer sessions going well, 21 present at Jan 14th. Next session will have students attending with 842 hedging plants and two trees to plant.

- 1. The Borough requires dates in order to be able to pay us the proceeds of their Bangers and Mash promotion. Hilary will mine the minutes for these.
- 2. We aim to repair surface at 9.30am on Saturday 4th February. Andrew will send out email asking for volunteer help.
- 3. Plaque will be installed soon, again volunteers will be sought to reduce time/manpower costs.
- 4. The QEII Field application has been approved by Lancaster City Council and we wait with bated breath to find out whether we have been successful. If the playground gets QEII status then it can never be used for any other purpose other than recreation.
- 5. Safety surface grant comes with conditions from County; we are going to need a Child Protection, Environmental and Complaints policy to be in place by June. Andrew will shoulder this burden.
- 6. Lights failed to be repaired. County Councillor Chris Coates and Hilary are both chasing.
