

Flora Metal Finds 10th Jan 2014



- The coins date from circa 1700, George I, II, III, V, VI, through to modern day, and include the two large "cartwheel" pennies of Geo III, c1797.
- Two silver sixpences of George V, 1928 & 1930.
- Small weight is Georgian, 1/4oz.
- Harness fittings, shoe buckle are the other items, including the piece on the left. This is a leg / foot, from a Medieval cooking pot / skillet, probably 14th-15th century

- Elizabeth I groat (4d) first issue 1559-60...top right
- Victoria shilling 1872
- George III sixpence 1817
- George V sixpence 1916
- Clog / shoe fastener c1760-1800
- Musket balls (used)
- 2 lead tokens (15th-16th century)
- lead seal / customs import tag, from flax bags. These came from St Petersburg, Russia. dated 1784.
